HOW TO COMPLETE THIS FORM:

PART ONE: NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

Candidates are allowed to apply for the Bronze Award themselves. However, they must supply details of a suitable referee, e.g. tutor, employer or supervisor. Applications and full citations must be received by **Monday 7 June 2010**. Candidates can be of any nationality. However, they must be either normally resident in the UK or working or studying in the UK when the contribution under consideration was made.

1. Please write the title, first name and surname of candidate in **BLOCK CAPITALS**
2. Please provide candidate's full home address
3. Please provide candidate's full business/university contact details – the more accurate the better. If successful IMechE staff will need to be able to contact the winner easily.
4. Briefly outline information concerning the candidate's first degree and/or subsequent employment experience. Include qualifications that are relevant to the nomination especially those relating to tribology.
5. Briefly outline relevant experience/training or postgraduate study of candidate: e.g. MSc/PhD details along with a list of candidate's main achievements to date.
6. Briefly describe the current employment/activities of the candidate, stating title of post and brief description of their role.
7. Briefly outline how the candidate plans to develop their career in tribology over the next five years.
8. A complete list of publications (which the candidate has authored or contributed to) must accompany an application.
9. If possible please obtain the candidate's signature and ask them to date the application.
10. Previous unsuccessful applicants will be reconsidered if updated applications are re-submitted.

PART TWO: NOTES FOR REFEREES

It is important that referees provide as much information as possible about the candidate's achievements in tribology. Applications and full citations must be received by **Monday 7 June 2010**.

11. Please write the title, first name and surname of referee in **BLOCK CAPITALS**
12. Please provide the contact full contact details of the referee to enable IMechE staff to contact the referee easily should the candidate be successful.
13. Referee's citations should highlight the candidate's contribution to tribology to date and outline their likely career in the immediate future. (Technical details of original contributions to the subject, the significance of the work done, details of the candidate's career achievements, positions held, refereed publications completed, conference presentations made, etc. will all be relevant.)
14. All referees should sign and date their reference.
