Monitored Professional Development Scheme (MPDS)

MPDS is an Accredited company scheme which follows an agreed structured programme, which can facilitate developing engineers in reaching the competence requirements for registration.



Supported Registration Scheme (SRS)

SRS is a non-accredited company scheme, which can support a developing engineer so they follow a structured development pathway, working with an internal company mentor.



Developing Engineers Programme

The Developing Engineers Programme is designed specifically for Associate Members. It helps you to achieve professional registration as efficiently as possible. Using the programme gives you the tools, support and structure you need, in a format that fits around the demands of your current and future career.

By-Law 31.3 states:

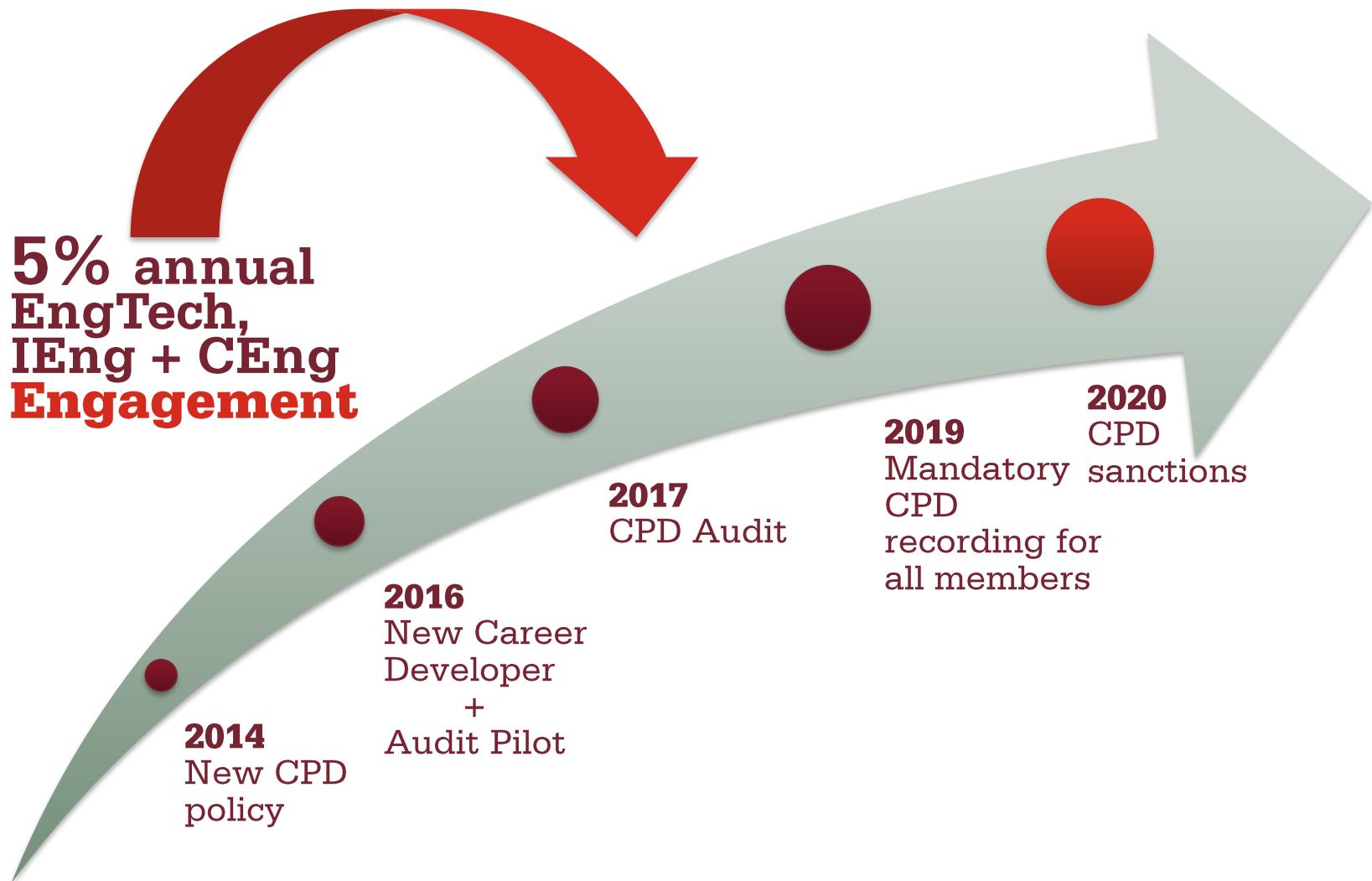
All members shall take reasonable steps to maintain appropriate professional competencies.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

How do I approach my professional development? >

CPD is personal and unique to your development. Our approach to CPD is about learning outcomes achieved rather than time spent on activities. We call this reflective practice.



What counts as CPD? >

So much of what engineers do every day counts towards their professional development, both at work and through extracurricular courses and interests. Often using UK-SPEC as a reference can help you.

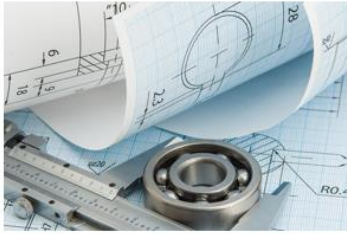

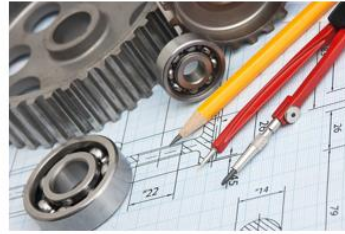

THE IMECHE'S APPROACH TO CPD.

CPD is based on **your** individual, reflective learning:

CPD does not have to be just formal training

There is no minimum requirement for your CPD

You are best placed to decide what is appropriate for you

CPD is about reflective learning not hours or points

The important aspect is what **you** get out of your CPD, not merely meeting a defined measurement

You have been doing lots of CPD already!

REFLECTIVE LEARNING.

This forms the **core** of the IMechE approach to CPD and can be considered as the process of answering the following sequence of questions:

Did I benefit from the activity?

How did I benefit?

How could I have benefited more?

How will I be able to use this experience constructively and further build on its effect in the future?

WHAT COUNTS AS ACCEPTABLE CPD?

Formal learning - 10%

Learning and developing through structured courses and programs

Examples:

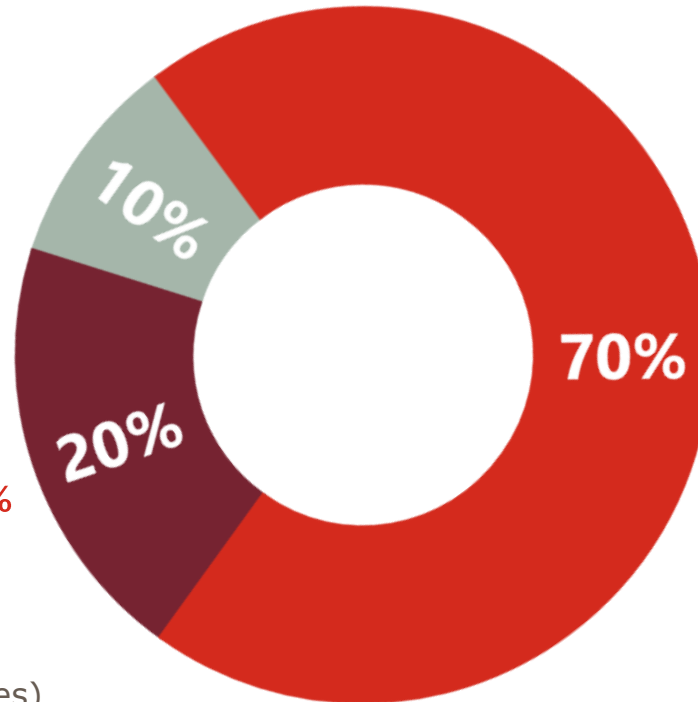

Learn from others – 20%

Learning and developing with and through others

Learn from experience – 70%

Learning and developing through day-to-day tasks, challenges and practice

Examples:

- Project assignments
- Project reviews
- Reading
- Research
- Placements
- Secondments
- Shadowing
- Increasing responsibility
- Challenging tasks
- Innovation
- Reflection

70:20:10 is a way of explaining how learning occurs at work. It represents a ratio of learning from experience (70%), learning from others (20%) and learning in a formal setting (10%).

a guideline, not a fixed ratio.

USE UK-SPEC AS YOUR GUIDE.

There are technical and non-technical areas of competence which all require ongoing development based upon your professional activities.

Another misconception is that CPD is just about maintaining technical engineering competence

Project work, management, communication, volunteering, community work etc. all count too

What do you do to ensure you are remaining competent to do your job effectively?
